- Dr. Chadi Assi received the Ph.D. degree from the City University of New York. He was a Visiting researcher with Nokia Research Center, Boston, MA, USA, where he worked on quality of service in passive optical access networks. In 2003, he joined the Concordia Institute for Information Systems Engineering, Concordia University, as an Assistant Professor, where he is currently a Full Professor and an IEEE Fellow.
